Course Improvements

12th Hole Drop Zone

Discussions took place as to the feasibility of a drop zone within the rules of golf or whether another local rule could be issued such as Out Of Bounds.

The Committee have agreed to look in detail at the problem and to make a decision as soon as possible.

A similar problem exists on the 18th hole with the 'temporary' fencing to the right of the fairway on the approach to the green. Due to the heavy rough adjacent to the fence in question some thought needs to be put into what course of action to take regarding sensible but legal relief.


